



## ULTRA CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2013

Kaiken are a distinct breed of geese that crisscross above the Andes Mountains from Chile to Argentina. Aurelio Montes – founder and Chilean winemaker of Montes Wines – fell in love with Argentina’s terroir-driven wines and created the Kaiken brand to reflect the best of both sides of the Andes. Kaiken remains a family-owned winery, as he has passed the winemaking torch to his son, Aurelio Montes Jr.

### KEY SELLING POINTS

- Same meticulous vineyard management and winemaking skills one would expect from Montes with the flare from the next generation
- Crafted with the expert skills of winemaker Aurelio Montes Jr., using grapes selected and hand-picked from the best sectors of the Vistalba vineyard in Mendoza
- Aged for 12 months in French oak barrels

**Variety:** 95% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Malbec

**Appellation:** Lujan de Cuyo, Mendoza, Argentina

**Winemaker Comments:** Deep red in color. Elegant and balanced on the nose, with ripe fruit aromas such as strawberries and cherries intertwined with a hint of black pepper and tobacco. The finish is long and lingering, with notes of red fruit mixed with subtle vanilla and chocolate from oak aging.
