## Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2013

(Broken Rock) Blessed with high drainage and low fertility soil on the eastern ridge of Napa Valley at the foot of Atlas Peak, Broken Rock consistently produces wines of unusual intensity and concentration.

(Las Piedras) – A signature Cabernet sourced entirely from Las Piedras. Known for its gravelly soil, this Beckstoffer Heritage vineyard traces its roots back to the original Mexican land grants more than 150 years ago.
